

## **Immunization Requirements 2011-2012 School Year - Reference Guide**

### **3 year olds and 4 year olds (PRE-K)**

4 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT

3 doses of Polio

1 dose of MMR on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

1 dose of HIB on/after 15 months **OR** 3 doses with the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose given on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday, and at least 2 months since dose #2

1 dose of PCV7\* on **OR** after 24 months of age or 4 doses of PCV7 with one given after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

1 dose of Varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox)

2 doses of Hepatitis A

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√ *HIB and PCV7 not routinely recommended to children  $\geq$  5 years of age*

\* *Other schedules may apply*

### **Kindergarten - Second Grade**

For entry into Kindergarten - Second grade in **2011-2012 new vaccine requirements** include:

5 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday **OR** 4 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

4 doses of Polio with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday **OR** 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of MMR on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

2 doses of Varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox disease)

2 doses of Hepatitis A

(MMR and Varicella doses must be administered a minimum of 28 days apart)

### **Third Grade – Sixth Grade**

4 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT, Td with one on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, (If 7 years or older 3 doses, with one dose on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday is acceptable.)

4 doses of Polio with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday **OR** 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of MMR

3 doses of Hepatitis B

1 dose of Varicella\*\*\* on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox)

### **Seventh Grade - Ninth Grade**

For entry into Seventh Grade - Ninth Grade in **2011-2012 new vaccine requirements** include:

1 dose Tdap ;(*Td is acceptable in lieu of Tdap if a contraindication to pertussis exists*)

1 dose Meningococcal Vaccine

2 doses of Varicella Vaccine (*written statement of varicella (chickenpox) disease-month and year- from parent, or varicella immunity per healthcare provider; is acceptable in lieu of either dose of varicella vaccine*)

3 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT, Td with one on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

4 doses of Polio with one on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday **OR** 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of Measles, 1 dose of Mumps, and 1 dose of Rubella on/after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

### **Tenth grade – Twelfth Grade**

3 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT, Td with one on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

1 dose Tdap/Td 10 years after last dose of tetanus containing vaccine

4 doses of Polio\*\* with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday **OR** 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of Measles, 1 dose Mumps and 1 dose Rubella on/after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

1 dose of Varicella\*\*\* on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox)

\*\* Polio not required for students 18 years or older

\*\*\* Two doses of varicella are required if child is  $\geq$  13 years old when first dose is given

\*\*\*\* Any changes in the State immunization requirements will be followed
